“*Deví*” is a collection of paintings based on stills from films. The women depicted on these canvases come from diverse cultural, social, and historical backgrounds. Their juxtaposition invites us to question how these women are connected. We find ourselves caught in the crossfire of their gazes, compelled to try to understand them. We strive to read the lines etched into their faces by experience—sometimes quite literally. Each painting encourages the viewer to imagine their stories.

At the heart of the collection is a diptych featuring children peering into the adult world—a world they cannot yet comprehend, yet one they are inevitably fated to inherit.

Nous essayons de déchiffrer les lignes que l’expérience a tracées, parfois littéralement, sur leurs visages. Chaque image invite le spectateur à imaginer les histoires de ces femmes.

Au cœur de la collection se trouve un diptyque montrant des enfants qui, à travers une fenêtre, observent le monde des adultes — un monde qu’ils ne peuvent pas encore comprendre mais qu’ils sont condamnés à reproduire à l’avenir.

|| In my creative work, the content always determines the form. When I have an idea for an art piece, I try to find the best medium to bring it to life. Sometimes the idea takes the form of a poem, a short story, a dramatic dialogue, a photograph, a film, a video game, or, most frequently, a painting. At times, these different mediums merge to create works that can be beautiful and/or hideous, transcendent and/or bizarre, romantic and/or deviant.

My art is profoundly narrative in nature. Each picture tells a story—or rather, a multitude of stories. Each picture is a window into a multiverse, where a myriad of possibilities complement and contradict each other. The viewer is more important than the artist because it is the viewer who ultimately decides the value of the artwork and their relationship with it.

|| Dans mon travail de création, le contenu détermine toujours la forme. Lorsque j'ai une idée pour une œuvre d'art, j'essaie de trouver le meilleur moyen de la matérialiser. Parfois, l'idée prend la forme d'un poème, d'une nouvelle, d'un dialogue dramatique, d'une photo, d'un film, d'un jeu vidéo ou, le plus souvent, d'une peinture. Parfois, ces différents moyens d'expression fusionnent et forment des créations qui peuvent être belles et/ou hideuses, transcendantes et/ou étranges, romantiques et/ou déviantes.

Mon art est profondément narratif. Chaque image raconte une histoire, ou plutôt une multitude d'histoires. Chaque image est une fenêtre sur un multivers où une myriade de possibilités se complètent et se contredisent. Le spectateur est plus important que l'artiste, car c'est lui qui doit prendre la décision finale sur la valeur de l'œuvre et sur sa relation avec elle.
